> Mrs. Burrow informed the Board that teachers and staff have returned for the new school year. Instruction on COVID-19 awareness precautions is being discussed. Training sessions such as, Google classroom, dyslexia, suicide, safety, intruder training are being attended by staff members. Mrs. Burrow reported that the district will work with all individual families as to what type of educational service they need.

8/19/2020 Activities Report

Mrs. Brinkmann informed the Board of the MSHSSA guidelines for athletic sports. All athletes will wear a mask unless they are in active play. All coaches will wear masks. All individuals in the press box. Concussion stand workers will wear a mask and gloves. Each athlete will have their temperature taken before each event. If an athlete has a temperature over 100 degrees that event will be cancelled. MSHSSA strongly recommends that spectators wear masks and social distance as much as possible. It was the consensus of the Board to highly recommend wearing a mask at all school events.

8/19/2020 COVID Plan Discussion was held on who makes the decision to change our COVID plan from A, to B, to C. Each circumstance will be evaluated individually. Social tracing will be in place. The Cole County Health Department will give strong guidance if necessary. The administration stated that we have some students requesting virtual learning. These details are being worked out at this time. The IT department will evaluate the equipment the students have at home and how it will connect with the district equipment. Mrs. Burrow stated that every situation is a little different and will be evaluated individually. Teachers will be given the necessary tools to work with virtual learning students.

8/19/2020 Handbook Change

Mr. Richard presented a handbook change which moves the Jr. High students back to tri-semester classes. This will also affect the High School students also due to the instructor's class schedules. Having tri-semester classes will work more efficiently if we would have to go to Plan B. Mr. Richard will change the calendar to show the change in grading periods. The first grading period will be October 2.
