2/22/21 Burrow Report Mrs. Burrow informed the Board that Cole County Health Dept. is working on a vaccination clinic for all Cole County School employees. This would be a day that we will be out of session to allow employees to attend the clinic and receive their vaccination.

Mrs. Burrow stated that at this time we have missed a total of 7 weather days or 48 hours. The DESE calendar requirement is 1044 hours. The district calendar for 2020-21 has 1152 hours built in. Therefore, as of now we will stay with our original calendar.

2/22/21 Richard Report Mr. Richard reported on High School activities. Enrollment is 302 with attendance at 96.88%. Mr. Richard reported that the Academic team has been competing virtually. The team recently won first against Fatima and Carthage in the Eugene President's Virtual Tournament. Caden Anderson and Braeden Short were named to the All-Tournament team. Girls Basketball finished 3rd in the Russellville Tournament. Boys Basketball finished 4th in the Eldon Tournament. FFA week is scheduled for 2/22-2/29.

2/22/21 Messersmith Report Mrs. Messersmith reported on Elementary activities. Enrollment is 333 with attendance at 95.99%. Mrs. Messersmith recognized the students of the month for character trait honesty. The Elementary Knowledge bowl will not be held at Lincoln University this year. The conference administrators are working out the details to host this event within their school. This will be for grades 4, 5 and 6. The Elementary tournament is scheduled for Monday, March 22 and Thursday, March 25. This tournament will be local teams from within our district. Mrs. Messersmith stated that Mrs. Carla Ousley would like to apply for a \$500.00 MSTA grant to purchase reading materials for her guided reading program. This is just a straight grant, no matching funds required. The Board gave consent for Mrs. Ousley to pursue the MSTA grant.

2/22/21 Tutoring Program Mr. Richard reported that we have students struggling with grades and virtual learning. Mr. Richard and Mrs. Adrian are recommending a tutoring program after school for students that currently have F's and D's. If a student has an F it would be required. If a student has a D it would be highly recommended. The Board inquired the number of students struggling. Mr. Richard reported approximately 30 students. This includes students just not completing their assignments. Mrs. Adrian plans to have National Honor Society students available for the tutoring program, in addition to core subject teachers. It was a suggestion to include A+ students if needed.

2/22/21 Soccer Program The Board discussed the possibility of starting a soccer program at Eugene. It has been noted that several students are interested in soccer. It was noted that the Board is not opposed to having a soccer program. The discussion has been the startup cost of the program; the necessary renovation to the field; the possibility of co-op with Calvary Lutheran; suggestion was made for fundraising to provide additional revenue; district budget concerns. After much discussion it was determined that the district will not co-op with Calvary Lutheran. A soccer committee will be established to move forward with obtaining bids for the renovation of the field. The budget balances will be reviewed.
