1/20/2021 Burrow Report

Mrs. Burrow reported that she is working on the budget for next year. The goal is to give the staff a decent raise and work toward getting the starting salary over \$30,000.00. Mrs. Burrow stated that she is in constant contact with Mr. Burch in regard to the budget for next year.

1/20/2021 Committee Reports

Mrs. Burrow informed the Board that Committee for Committees met earlier on January 20, and has decided to change their name to Committee Leadership Team. Reports that came from the meeting included; Summer School will be offered this summer to incoming K-8 students. Mrs. Messersmith stated that Summer Journey's Program will start on May 18th - June 15th. Pam Lepper will remain on the Eagle Pride Committee. Tawyna Morrow will report for the Recognition Committee, Lynette Proctor reported that the goal is to have chrome books for every student grades 7-12. The track committee will be meeting on January 27. The committee representative wanted it mentioned that they are working toward electricity at the track. The hot spot for the track area will need electricity. COVID committee started in March. Mrs. Burrow is in constant communication on COVID guidelines as they change. Mrs. Burrow informed the Board that the CRA COVID leave has been extended until March 31st for employees that must take off work due to COVID related illness. This extension is up to the discretion of the employer. The extension does not include additional hours, the total hours are 80. If an employee has not used all 80 hours prior to this extension they made use the remaining hours up to 80 hours. When an employee has used all 80 hours they must use sick leave.

COVID Leave

1/20/2021 7834 Motion by Mrs. Bradley to extend the CRA leave for COVID related illnesses through March 31, 2021. Motion second by Mrs. Smith. Answering aye: Carrender, Bradley, Smith, Angerer, Hoskins, Sommerer and Hale. No nays. Motion carried.

1/20/21 Messersmith Report Mrs. Messersmith reported on Elementary activities. Enrollment is at 330 with attendance at 94.97%. Second quarter grades were sent home on January 8th. February 5th is the middle of the third quarter and those grades will be sent out on February 11<sup>th</sup>.

1/20/2021 Richard Report Mr. Richard reported on High School activities. Enrollment is at 302 and attendance is at 96.77%. Homecoming is rescheduled for February 6<sup>th</sup>. Eugene will host the ACT exam on February 6<sup>th</sup>, and the ASVB exam will be given to juniors on February 9<sup>th</sup>.

1/20/2021 COVID Update Mrs. Burrow gave a COVID update. Discussion has been on hosting a vaccination site. School staff members have been moved to Tier I-C. 50% of our district staff is interested in getting the vaccination. Mrs. Burrow will keep the Board informed on any changes as they occur.

1/20/2021 Student Recognition Student recognition has been discussed at previous meetings. The Board voiced the importance of recognizing students for their academic achievements as much as their athletic achievements. All coaches should be encouraged to recognize their student athlete's academic success. It should be noted that guidelines for Academic All State are different for each sport. The criteria for this recognition should be included in the Athletic Handbook. The Board would also like to see recognition be presented in a more timely fashion.

1/20/2021 Soccer Program Mrs. Burrow reported that Mr. Richard, Mrs. Brinkman and she meet with the Calvary Lutheran AD and administration concerning the possibility of co-op for a soccer program. Discussion included no co-ed teams. Fifteen students would be needed for each team. The boy's season would be in the fall, girl's season in the spring. Calvary would take the lead with the boys in the fall. Eugene would go with the girls in the spring. The canceling of fall baseball at Eugene was mentioned. There would need to be several issues resolved. Such as practice schedules, getting students to practices will require our students being bused to Calvary. The Calvary administration will take this information to their Board.

Mrs. Brinkman outlined estimated expenses with starting soccer. The following are only estimated expenses; transportation cost \$16,000, officials \$2000, coaches stipend \$5244, plus uniforms expenses and general supplies.

Due to budget constraints the current sports budget has been very limited.

Mrs. Burrow stated a decision will need to be made by the February meeting to make this happen in the fall.

1/20/2021 Elementary Tournament The administration recommended not hosting the elementary basketball tournament this year due to COVID concerns. Mrs. Messersmith did voice this is a fund raiser for the elementary. There are supplies that will need to be ordered, medals, concession stand items, officials if the district intends to go forward with the tournament. Mr. Hoskins noted that we have several students already participating in basketball leagues. For Eugene not to host the tournament would be very disappointing to our students. Mrs. Bradley suggested that we possibly due a smaller version of the tournament with just Eugene students. The administration will do a survey to see how many teams would be available.

1/20/21 Grant Stipends Mrs. Smith suggested the possibility of compensating teachers to write grants. Any grants would need Board approval. One concern would be most instructional grants are matching grants. This item will be revisited next month.

Mrs. Burrow presented the proposed 2021-2022 school calendar for next year. 1/20/2021 Mrs. Burrow has shared the calendar with Mr. Burch. More professional 2021-2022 development days were suggested for the first semester. With the state Calendar mandate to have a later start date for district's and the Thanksgiving and Christmas breaks it is hard to accommodate more PD days. 1/20/2021 7835 Motion by Mr. Angerer to approve the 2021-2022 school calendar as presented.
