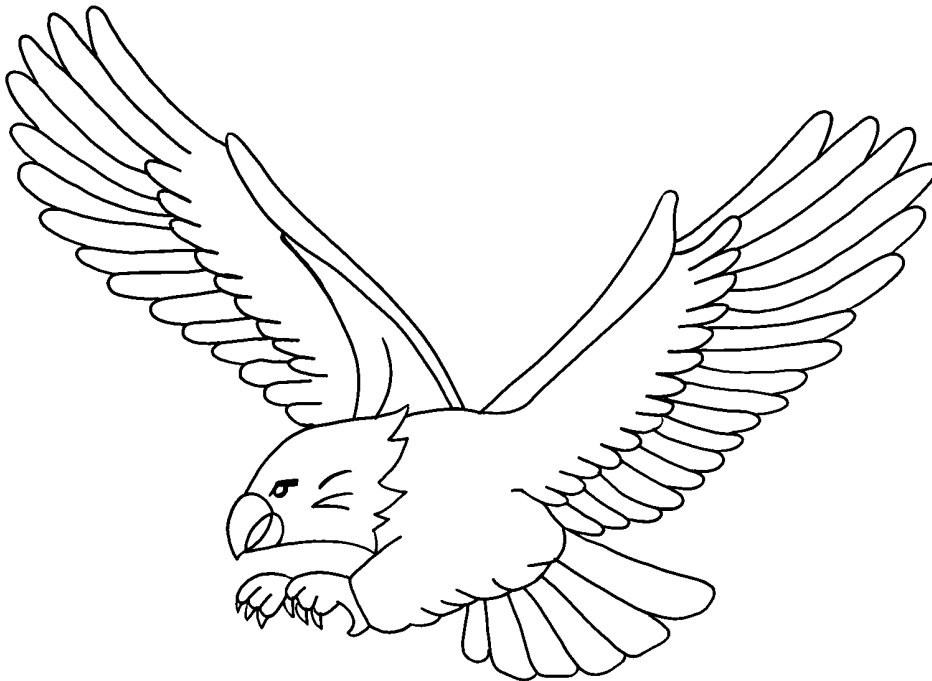
### **BELIEF STATEMENTS:**

## **WELCOME TO THE COLE COUNTY R-V SCHOOL DISTRICT**

We are proud of our teachers, students, school and our outstanding accomplishments. We strive to ensure that each of our students has every opportunity to reach their maximum potential. Our district includes the towns of Eugene, Mary's Home, Brazito, Henley, and Honey Creek. Our district serves approximately 700 students in grades K-12. The district employs 63 certified staff and 28 support staff. The average student/teacher ratio is 15:1. The newly opened preschool currently has a full enrollment of 20 children and is staffed with a Director and 2 aides. The school is located on Highway 17 outside of Eugene approximately 20 miles south of Jefferson City. The Cole County R-V School is the largest employer in the district.



## Academic Performance

The Cole County R-V School has received a full waiver for fourth cycle MSIP. The District has maintained its fully accredited rating from the State Board of Education. This accreditation reflects the hard work of the students and staff, as well as the support of district patrons. The district averages 94.6% attendance and maintains a graduation rate of 90.2% over the last four years. Approximately 53% of our students pursue post-secondary education. The district is an A+ designated school. The students and staff of the district are dedicated to the continual improvement of student achievement.



## **Parental Involvement**

The district maintains an open door policy. Parents are welcome to visit the school. If you wish to see a specific teacher, you should schedule an appointment in advance. To assist in maintaining security, we request that parents and patrons of the district enter the building through either the High School entrance or the Elementary entrance and that visitors of our building check-in with the school office. Our district has a Parent as Teachers Program, which serves children from birth to the age of 5. We have very active Booster Clubs for our music and athletic departments. The FFA Alumni Organization supports the FFA department. We also have a PTO that is very instrumental in helping to fund activities within the elementary.



## Technology

Our district has over 250-networked computers with Internet access. This includes at least one computer in each classroom. A T1 line through MOREnet provides our Internet access. Currently, we have a business/computer lab, an accounting lab, a junior high technology lab, a high school technology lab, an elementary lab, and a library media lab. Administrators and faculty utilize e-mail on a regular basis for communication. Students in grades K-12 currently utilize labs on a regular basis. The district continues to search out new sources of revenue to continually improve the technology within the district.
